The Resort is situated in the tropical surrounds of Pacific Harbour between Suva and Nadi boasting absolute beachfront that stretches for miles. From all entertainment areas, you will enjoy the uninterrupted views and breath-taking beauty of Beqa and Yanuca Islands.

The interiors are fresh with white backgrounds interlaced with rich browns, reds and creams and finished with high quality fabrics, leather and wood. Oversized day beds, comfy sofas, and large coffee tables are scattered throughout the resort for guests to lounge back and enjoy, whilst taking in the views of the beach, river and gardens.

Events Bure



The Pearl Championship Golf Course & Country Club

CHILDREN'S FACILITIES

The Pearl South Pacific caters specifically for the adult market, ensuring their every need is served. As such, the hotel is able to provide a nanny service by appointment, enabling children to be well cared for whilst parents enjoy a well-deserved break. Nannies are able to care for children either in-room or on-ground. Pending age and number of children, activities can be pre-approved by parents for their children to undertake.

The Pearl South Pacific has a limited number of highchairs and cots, which must be requested prior to arrival to ensure availability.
